

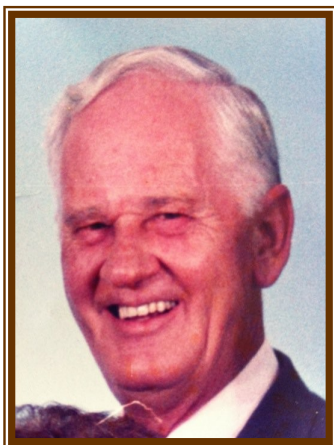

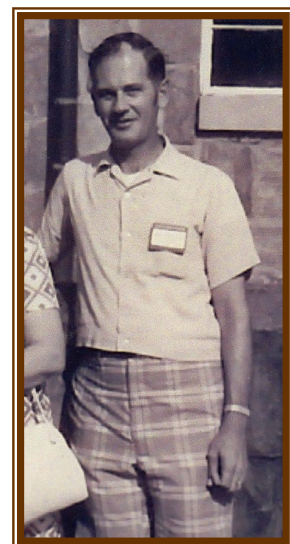
Graduation Day JAMES DONALD BREW 8/22/1927 - 3/6/2016
