Now Paul is trying to arrange with Pastor Kitambala (who returned to Lodja yesterday via motorbike to purchase a beef for the conference) to catch a truck today going back to Kela and hoping to return to Lodja on Monday with the fuel. Sounds simple enough, doesn't it? Please help us pray that is the case.

Both Roy Lauter and Hubert Harriman need to fly to Kananga on Tuesday and the Bishop and his wife, too, only they will fly out on Friday. Currently, there is not enough fuel to get back for one trip to Kananga, so we need this fuel from Kela for the plane. The fuel is not marked clearly so pray for the Pastor that he will easily be able to identify it.

Today the Bishop wants to end the camp with communion, so last night our cook stayed up late cooking bread. I need to start cutting the pieces for it. He is expecting over a thousand!

Please continue your prayers. God has blessed and the altar has been filled many times over. Pray for the hearts and souls that have been convicted and blessed to begin maturing in HIM over the months and years to come.
