Kinshasa is calm today and people are back on the streets. Evidently, the accord between Kabila and Mumba is working for the time being.

There were no flights today so Roy and Hubert are still in Kananga but could possibly get out on a UN flight this afternoon to Kinshasa. If not, then they are suppose to fly to Kin tomorrow and then fly out tomorrow night on their flight back to the states.

There is a pickup coming for us from Lodja. We are in the mist of packing up the house though leaving enough for the Bishop and his wife to be comfortable and able to eat.

We may get off around 5 a.m. We will have about a 6-7 hour trip going the 100 miles back to Lodja.

We are scheduled to fly out of Lodja on Friday afternoon and then Saturday evening to the states.

Since flights have not flown for 2-3 days there are a lot of extra passengers wanting to fly so we would appreciate your prayers for all of us that will be flying.

The scriptures tell us to be anxious for nothing-wow-that is difficult right now! We are physically weary now so we would appreciate it if the Lord would allow us to go on to the states.

We do trust His timing.
