Today Paul and the team went to the forest to load up the boards that were sawed almost two weeks ago now.

The Minister of Defense loaned us one of his trucks that is smaller than our truck and able to cross the two small bridges going into the forest where our boards were located. It then brought them back and off loaded them with the help of our team, then they reloaded the boards onto our truck. (Our truck also carries twice as much as his does and why it could not cross the small bridges.)

Our plans now are to load our truck up tomorrow with as many boards as we need to get the tabernacle started, cement, nails, barrels of fuel, wood cookstove, kerosene deep freeze, mattresses, housewhole supplies, groceries, charcoal, etc. We hope to get it off early afternoon in order to get to the ferry in time to cross before dark.

Then on Friday morning early, Paul, the team and myself will leave in a borrowed pick up and begin the 6-8 hour trip. This will be about 100 miles. The big truck will take about 12 hours but it does carry up to 10 tons.

With your many prayers, it seems we may at long last be heading to Katako Kombe and the construction sight for the camp meeting! Saturday should be spent unloading and perhaps beginning the first stages of the tabernacle construction. I will be setting up house while Paul and the team work on the camp sight.

Please pray that our plans will go 'as planned' and that we will safely get to KK. Please continue your much needed prayers for us.
